**2021/22 SOUTHEAST ALASKA COMMERCIAL SEA CUCUMBER FISHERY
ANNOUNCEMENT**

The 2021/22 Southeast Alaska sea cucumber fishery **will remain closed until further notice**. There was no harvest last week and currently no processors are interested in purchasing sea cucumbers. The combined remaining guideline harvest levels of 13,000 pounds will be available for harvest until the season closes by regulation on March 31, 2022. The department will consider reopening these areas if there is interest. Interested divers and processors should contact Ketchikan Area Management staff prior to 12:00 noon on Thursday for a potential fishery the following week.
