SOUTHEAST ALASKA COMMERCIAL GEODUCK FISHERY ANNOUNCEMENT

The following area will be open for the commercial harvest of geoduck for live sale **from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Wednesday, February 16, and from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Thursday, February 17, 2022:**

Kaigani Strait (Subdistrict 103-30-001): will be open for a guideline harvest level of 30,300 pounds of geoduck.

Fishermen are reminded that unless otherwise specified, regulations regarding the geoduck fishery are stated in 5 AAC 38.142: Southeastern Alaska Geoduck Fishery Management Plan.

For a description of the above area, please refer to the Southeast Alaska commercial geoduck fishery announcement dated September 17, 2021, announcing the open areas and their guideline harvest levels. All companies buying geoduck clams must contact the Fish and Game, Ketchikan office with a harvest report before **12:00 noon on Friday, February 18, 2022.**

State offices will be closed on Monday, February 21, 2022, in observance of Presidents' Day.
